Greetings To All My Friends;

I trust this finds you strong in the Lord and the power of His might. Be encouraged to know our God is able to do abundantly above all that we can ask or think. He is a great God.

It has been awhile since I last wrote. The Lord has done some great things through our ministry this year and so I wanted to sit down and share with you. We have traveled the world and back this year and I am so grateful, that for each trip, the Lord miraculously provided the way. My first trip this year was back in March when I traveled to Columbia, South America. I had the privilege of taking a lady with me, that was a friend of my parents, who feels the Lord has called her to the nations. Her name is Gloria and she was such a blessing to me. I had never met her before. We met in the airport in Houston, Texas. But it was obvious from the very beginning, that God had joined us together. It was also an added bonus that Gloria speaks Spanish. So, I guess you could say I brought my own interpreter with me.

I was very excited to be back in Columbia. That is always a highlight in my life. Of all the places I have been and all the different kinds of people that I have met, there is nobody like the Colombian people. They are so very precious. They treated Gloria and I like queens. We ministered at Semillas Devida, for 3 days. As usual God moved in some powerful ways. At the time we came, the church was in under great warfare. That made things a bit tough for us, but God prevailed. We taught on healing, worship, the Holy Spirit and a very special message God had given concerning the things we need to make it through these last days. By the time we left, many had been healed in their body, saved, set free and there were numerous filled with the Holy Ghost. Praise be unto the Lord. It was sad to say goodbye, but the Colombians are always in my heart. I love them dearly.

I got home safely from South America. I immediately went back to work at my local church. In fact, I had to preach the following day. God has been doing some awesome things here in my local church body. We have experienced some powerful moves of the Holy Spirit. Many have been ministered to in very special ways. We have had healings, restoration, and again numerous people filled with the Holy Ghost. Our young people in our church, have had a wave of revival sweep amongst them. We have had several young people come to us, who were so bound with evil spirits. When they first came, it looked like an impossible situation. But praise God, NOTHING is impossible with the Lord. I started with a small amount of kids in my youth and we have more than doubled our youth group over the course of this year. Many came to us bound with devils, on drugs and with a broken heart. ALL of them, so far, have given their lives to the Lord, been set free from the devil, delivered from drugs and ALL have been filled with the Holy Ghost. I am so thankful to the Lord for what he has done with my youth. They are the next generation to take the gospel forth.

I was not home long before it was time to leave again. The next trip I took, we traveled to the nation of Israel. I didn't go alone. Again, Gloria joined me on this trip, as well as my parents. This trip was a dream come true for me. When I was little girl, the Lord visited me and took me to a foreign land. In this land, I ministered to a people of dark skin, who were bound with chains by the hands and the feet. As I began to pray for them, the chains fell off and they were set free. The Lord said to me, I have called you to this nation. Some time later, my dad was preaching at someone's church and we went to there house to eat after church; and they had this painting on the wall. When I saw the painting, I said to my mother, "that is where the Lord took me in my dream!" That painting was a picture of Jerusalem. After all these years, that dream came to pass.

We did massive amounts of site seeing while we were there. Our first place to site see was right there in Jerusalem. We visited the mount of olives and the garden tomb site. We were able to go to the wailing wall. We also went to the place where Jesus spent 40 days and nights fasting a praying. Not too far from there, is also the place where Judas Iscariot hung himself. Later we actually got to go tour the tabernacle site. Wow did we learn some awesome information. We were able to see and learn so many things.

We were not there just to site see. We went there to preach. So after a few days we headed south to a city called Eliat. This is the last city in Israel, before you cross on over into Egypt. This city was actually the very first city established, by the children of Israel, when they came out of the wilderness. We stayed right there on the Red Sea. Which, by the way, I had the privilege of being baptized in the Red Sea. What a beautiful place. While we were there, we ministered in a local Russian church. There is quite a bit of a Russian migration there in Israel. Later in our stay, we preached to nine different nations. Just in the congregation alone, there were Israeli's, Russian, Irish, German and American present. However, we preached over the internet, where many other nations had joined in. We were delighted to see that our Colombian friends had joined us through the internet. As well as Chile, France, Australia and Peru. We had a wonderful interpreter. In fact, she is the Bishop of the nation of Israel. She speaks like 9 or 10 languages. So as we preached, she had to interpret into several different languages. She is an amazing woman. We had a real move of the spirit in those meetings.

As we traveled back to Tel Aviv, the Bishop gave us a very special tour of Israel. We stopped at a place called the Masada, and learned some interesting history there. We also, stopped along the dead sea. That is a very mysterious place. They call the waters of the dead sea, healing waters. We even got see where Lot's wife had looked back and turned to a pillar of salt.

God used us on our travels to Israel and we are so thankful for that. But He ministered to each of us in a very special way as well. There was much impartation that came upon each of us. Our lives have changed in a very big way. That was not my last trip to Israel. While we were there, God gave me a prophet word that He had called me to be the mother of Jerusalem. WOW!!!

Upon my return God had birthed a new vision on the inside of me. My desire is to start a bible college. I have a strong desire to mentor and teach many who feel the calling of God upon their lives. So, this past August, I went back to college to get my degree in Theology and Divinity. I will have to have at least a masters to start my bible college. I have a bit of a ways to go. Please pray for me in that endeavor.

Many of you may know, that my husband Todd is in the military. For the past 6 plus years, we have been stationed in Denver, Colorado. The Lord has truly been good to us here. However, the time has come, that we are now being transferred to a new place. My husband recently got word that, we are moving to Dallas, Texas. I truly believe this is where God wants us. Of course, I am from Texas, so you can imagine that I am ecstatic. But, the interesting thing about this move is that I had felt God was calling me to the Dallas area a few months back. I had asked my husband if there were any military positions there in Dallas. On numerous occasions, he told me there were not any positions or reserve units in Dallas. Only in Houston. Well, the Army decided recently, that they needed to open a unit in the Dallas area. They picked my husband to fill a position there. So, that confirmed what I had felt in my heart for quite some time.

I will be traveling to Israel again at the end of May. Upon my return, I will be making my way to Texas. For many years now, I have worked in the Ophthalmology business. But I feel God is calling me to full-time ministry. So, when I leave Colorado, I will leave that medical career behind. I covet your prayers in this new endeavor for me. Also, please pray with us that the Lord will help us sell our house here in Colorado quickly.

One last note before I close. If there are any of you interested in learning about Israel, I have some DVD's that I would like to make available to you. You will learn some history of Israel, and the importance of Israel in these last days. I will also teach you on these DVD's about the tabernacle and its importance in our lives.
